## COURT HISTORY

- 1988 – Nine communities, at the urging of the Waukesha County Circuit Court, formed Wisconsin’s first joint municipal court.
- 1990 – Village of Dousman joins
- 1998 – Court becomes self-sufficient
- 2000 – Name changed to Lake Country Municipal Court
- 2000 – Town of Lisbon contracts for services
- 2002 – Village of Sussex contracts for services
- 2002 – Town of Lisbon becomes a member
- 2002 – Town of Delafield contracts for services
- 2003 – Village of Sussex becomes a member
- 2002 – Court goes online with state-wide recognized website:

- 2004 – Town of Delafield becomes a member
- 2004 – Town of Ixonia contracts for services
- 2006 – Town of Erin contracts for services
- 2007 – Village of Merton contracts for services
- 2008 – Town of Erin becomes a full member
- 2009 – Village of Sullivan contracts for services

Lake Country Municipal Court currently serves more municipalities than any other joint court in Wisconsin.

### Governance of the Municipal Court is accomplished:

- Administrative Committee – one member from each participating community entitled to vote. The Administrative Committee meets once or twice a year, generally, to consider and approve major items, including annual budget.
- Operations Committee – meets monthly, consists of three members of the participating communities. This committee directs the general operation and payment of bills, etc. of the municipal court.
- Personnel Committee – this committee meets as needed.
- Long Range Plan Committee – meets approximately once per year to discuss and advise the Administrative Committee on issues relating to growth, space, etc.
